NEW DATE FOR YOUR DIARY - Wednesday 26th February 2020

The Neighbourhood Environment team from Ards and North Down Borough Council will be visiting our children on **Wednesday 26th February** with a very exciting visitor. Charlie the Golden Retriever!

Charlie is a friendly, trained and calm dog who has been to many school educational talks over the past 8 years. There will be an interactive talk which will teach the children the following key areas:-

- How to approach a dog,
- How to stroke a dog properly
- What warning signs to look for
- How to protect yourself
- Doggie language
- Dogs around food and toys

The talk will last approx. 20 minutes with the opportunity for the children to ask questions. The children will also get the opportunity to pet Charlie - the right way!

RECIPE TO TRY AT HOME!

In January our children's favourite were definitely scones. This is our tried and tested Nursery School recipe.

Scones

- 1lb soda bread flour
 - 3oz butter
 - $\frac{1}{2}$ pint buttermilk
 - 3oz caster sugar
 - 2 large eggs
1. Mix together dry ingredients.
 2. Whisk eggs and buttermilk.
 3. Combine all ingredients, roll our mix and cut out scones using a round cutter.
 4. Bake at 180°C for 20 minutes.
